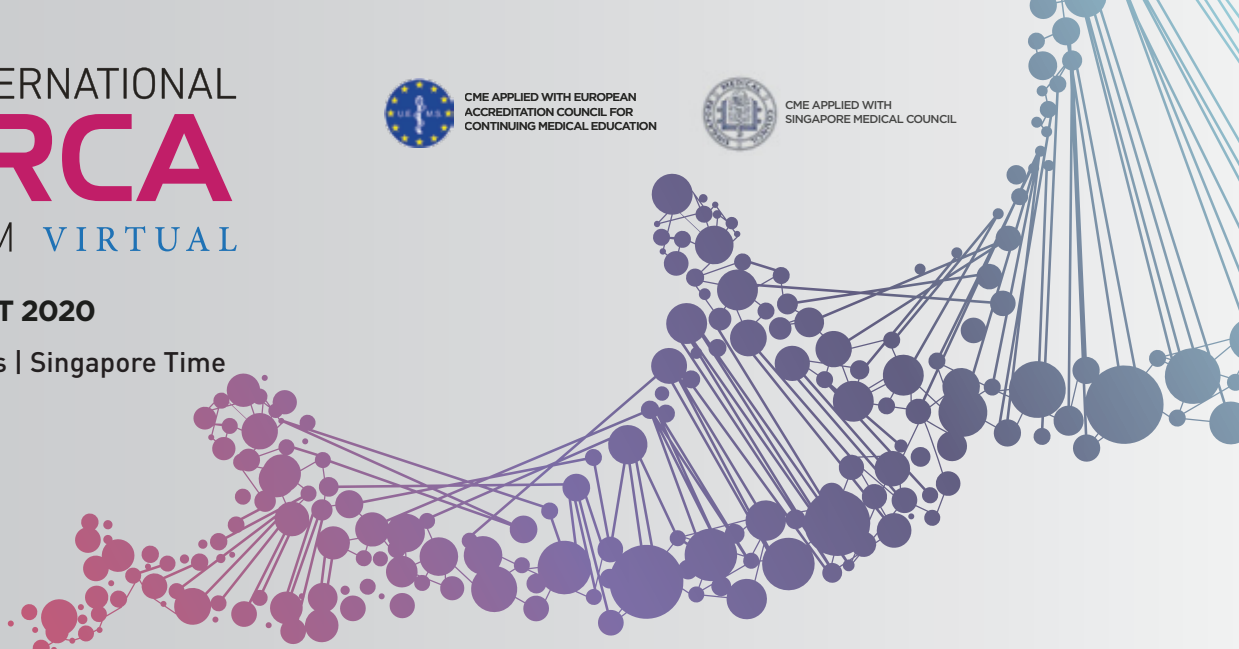

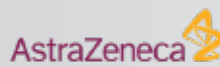

**Ava Kwong**

Dr. Ava Kwong is the Chief of Breast Surgery Division, Clinical Associate Professor and Assistant Dean at the University of Hong Kong, and University of Hong Kong – Shenzhen Hospital. She founded Hong Kong Hereditary Breast Cancer Family Registry, where she serves as the Chairman.



**Eileen M. O'Reilly**

Dr. Eileen O'Reilly, MD is a Oncology Specialist in New York, NY and has over 30 years of experience in the medical field. Dr. O'Reilly has more experience with Pancreatic Oncology, Gastrointestinal Oncology, and Pulmonary Oncology than other specialists in her area.



**Ghassan Abou-Alfa**

Dr. Ghassan Abou-Alfa is an oncologist in New York, NY and is affiliated with Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center. He specializes in gastrointestinal cancer and is experienced in gastrointestinal oncology, general medical oncology, and liver cancer, biliary cancer, pancreatic cancer.



**Joanne Ngeow**

Dr Joanne Ngeow, MBBS, MRCP, MPH is Senior Consultant, Division of Medical Oncology at the National Cancer Centre Singapore and Associate Professor, Lee Kong Chian School of Medicine, Nanyang Technological University. Dr John Chia is a medical oncologist practicing at Mount Elizabeth Novena Hospital, Singapore. His subspeciality interests include ovarian, endometrial, cervical, breast and colorectal cancers, as well as the management of rare tumours such as melanoma, uterine sarcoma, and germ cell tumours.



**Karmen Wong**

Dr Karmen Wong is a medical oncologist with over than 20 years of clinical practice. She received her oncology training in the National University Hospital (NUH), National Cancer Centre, Singapore (NCC) and University of California, San Francisco (UCSF). She helped establish the first multi-disciplinary breast cancer treatment in Singapore NCC, which created a platform for treatment in other cancer types with doctors of different disciplines.



**Klaus Schuster**

Dr Klaus Schuster is currently the Vice President for Medical Affairs at Caris Life Sciences for the International Medical Team (outside the US). As a medical doctor trained and board certified in internal medicine he has been working previously in the field of oncology in Austria for more than 10 years.



**Lee Soo Chin**

Dr. Lee Soo Chin is currently Head and Senior Consultant in Medical Oncology and Associate Director of Research at the National University Cancer Institute, Singapore, and Senior Principal Investigator at the Cancer Science Institute, Singapore. She specialises in breast cancer and directs the Cancer Genetics program at the National University Cancer Institute, Singapore. Her research focus is on breast cancer, pharmacogenetics and cancer genetics



**Nitesh Rohatgi**

Dr. Nitesh Rohatgi is a senior consultant in Medical Oncology at Max Hospital in Saket, who was till recently working at the prestigious London Oncology Clinic (Leaders in Oncology care), Harley Street, London. He is a fellow of the Royal Society of medicine and has much publication to his name. He was trained in medical oncology, palliative medicine and teenage young adult's cancers in United Kingdom, completing his CCT in 2009.

He has held leadership positions and contributed to national and community cancer programs. Prof. Rajiv Sarin is the Director of Advanced Centre for Treatment Research and Education in Cancer (ACTREC), Tata Memorial Centre, Mumbai. He is In-Charge of the Cancer Genetics Unit & Professor of Radiation Oncology at the Tata Memorial Centre. His research interests include Cancer Genetics, Breast cancer, Technology development & Public health



**Ravindran Kanesvaran**

Assoc Prof. Ravindran Kanesvaran is a Deputy Head and Senior Consultant in the Department of Medical Oncology of the National Cancer Centre Singapore. He is also an Associate Professor at Duke-NUS Graduate Medical School and clinical senior lecturer at the Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine, National University of Singapore. He is actively involved in graduate medical education and is the Program Director of the Medical Oncology Senior Residency Program. His research interests include GU oncology and geriatric oncology.



**Robert Coleman**

Dr. Coleman received his doctor of medicine degree from Creighton University in Omaha, Nebraska and completed his Obstetrics & Gynecology residency at Northwestern University Medical Center in Chicago, Illinois. Dr. Coleman's research interests include drug discovery and novel therapeutics for ovarian, uterine, and cervical cancer, clinical trial development and statistical design.



**Shaheenah Dawood**

Shaheenah Dawood is a Consultant medical oncologist and associate professor in clinical oncology in the United Arab Emirates. She currently leads the oncology clinical trials program at Mediclinic City Hospital Dubai. She also serves as president of Excellence In Oncology Care Congress that is held annually in Dubai and is co-president of the Asia Pacific Breast Cancer Summit (ABCS) and Asia Pacific Gastrointestinal Cancer Summit (APGCS). She has also recently launched the international BRCA forum and MENA immune-oncology summit.

Dr Shona Nag is known for her work in women's health - especially breast cancer and cervical cancer. With over 27 years of practise, Dr Shona Nag is currently the Director of Oncology at Sahayadri Group of Hospitals in Pune, Dr Shona Nag has been instrumental in helping patients navigate cancer better by also looking at pushing for new facilities and better care.



**Tira Tan**

Practicing at National Cancer Centre Singapore, Dr Tira Tan's research interest is in the study of breast cancer and geriatric oncology. In particular, her focus is on triple negative breast cancer and the conduct of early phase clinical trials. She has conceptualized and written several investigator-initiated protocols one of which has started actively recruiting patients.



**Yoon Sook Yee**

Ms. Yoon has been involved in the Malaysian Breast Cancer (MyBrCA) research project at Cancer Research Malaysia since 2003. She is one of two certified Genetic Counsellors in Malaysia, and is accredited by the Human Genetics Society Australasia (FHGSA). Her current focus is on hereditary cancers, such as breast and ovarian cancer patients and their families with a research interest in the psychological aspects of genetic testing and counselling in Malaysia.
